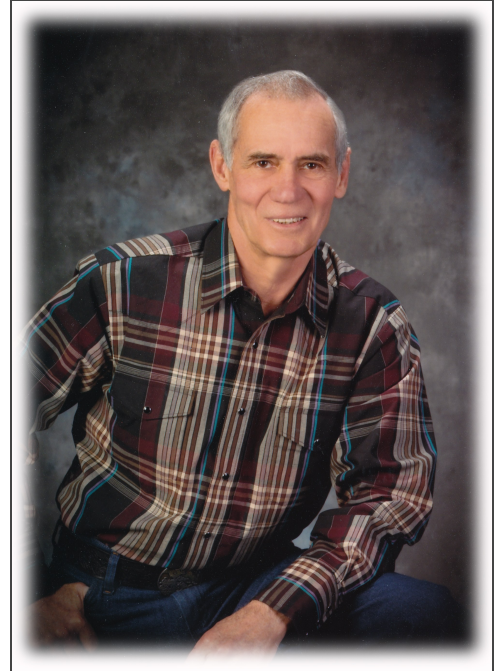


Leonard Vernon Page
