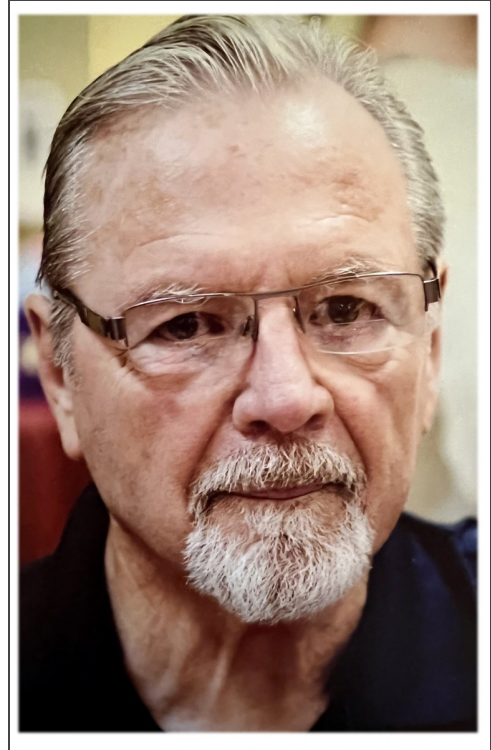

Stan passed away on Thursday, July 21, 2022 at the age of 84.

He is lovingly remembered by his wife of 56 years, Marge; his daughter, Susan; his son, Keith (Becca Ulrich); and stepdaughter, Michele Green (Hal Larson).
