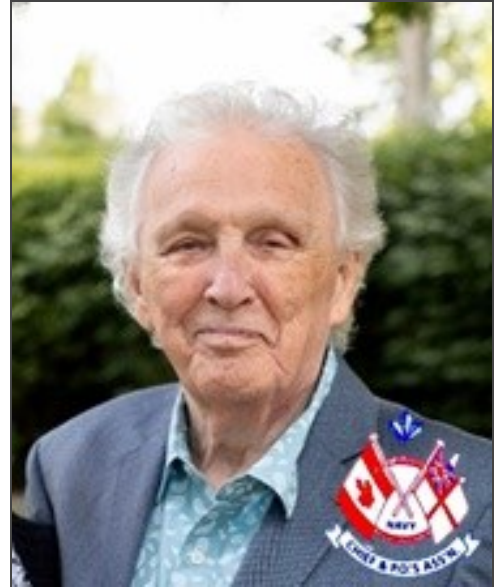


# Alan George Parkin
