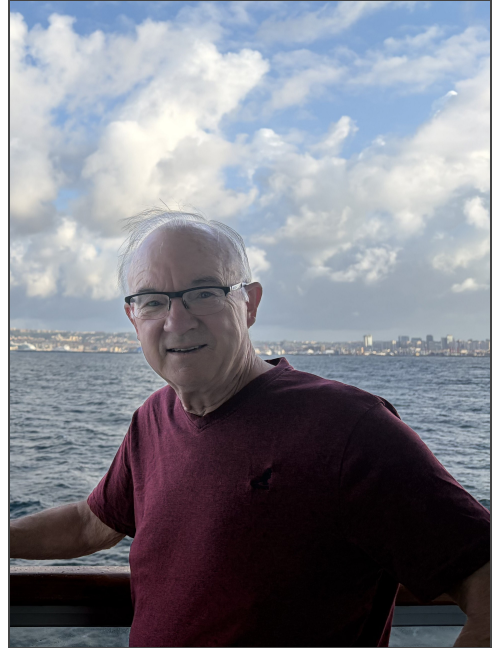


Patrick "Pat" Skwarok

Patrick "Pat or Paddy" Skwarok passed away June 3rd, 2026. whole life in the bush teaching others his natural talents. He loved being in nature: he was always willing to go for a walk, he loved camping, swimming in the pool, and tending to his garden. Pat was an excellent cook. He loved trying new foods then teaching himself to make it for the family. He was always quick with a “Dad joke” and was kind and generous with everyone who knew him.
