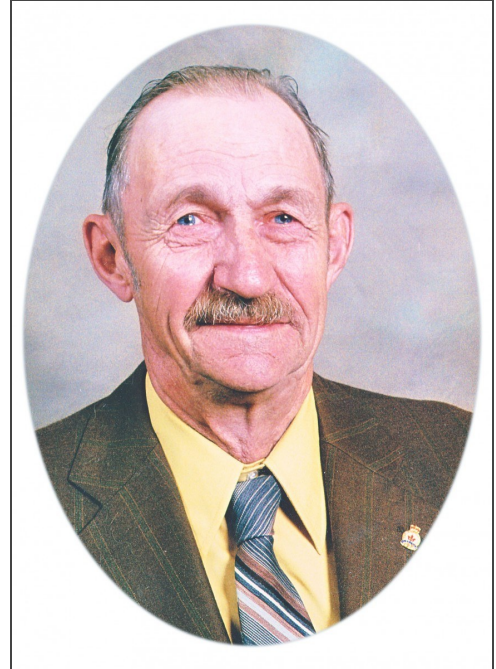


# Tom Patterson

Upon returning home from the war he married his beloved wife Arlene and continued to farm until their retirement in 2000 when they moved to Didsbury, AB.
