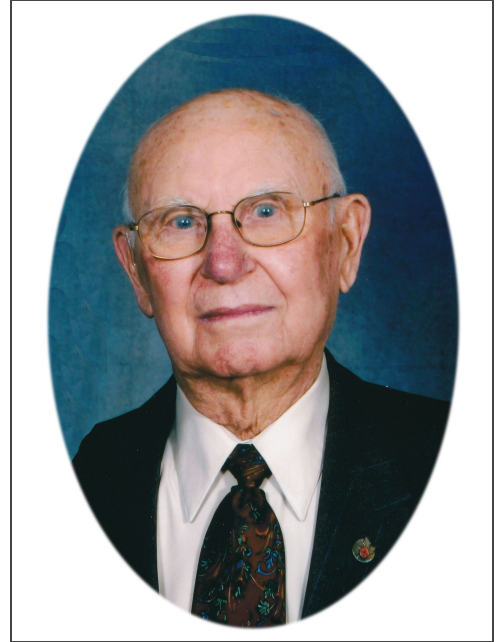


Orval Patzer
