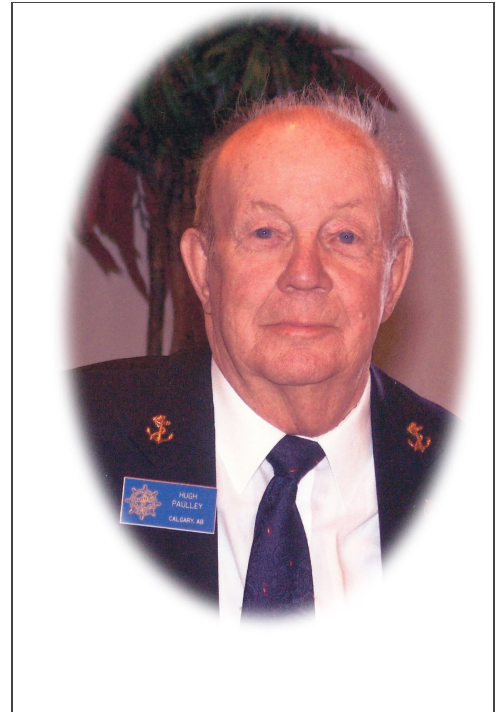


# Hugh Clifford Paulley
