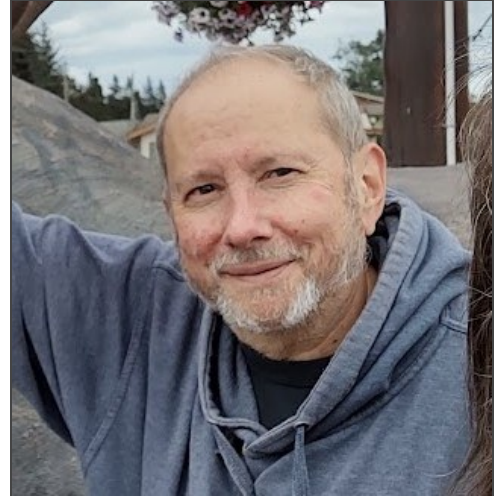


# Peter Deutsch
