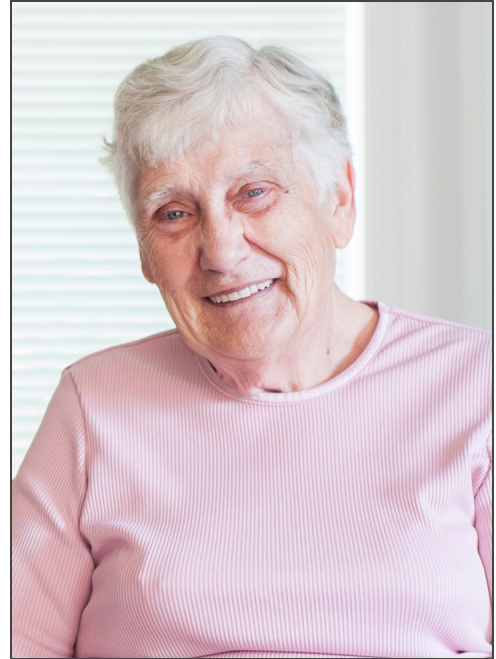


Agnes Peters
