

# Elwood "Al" Peters

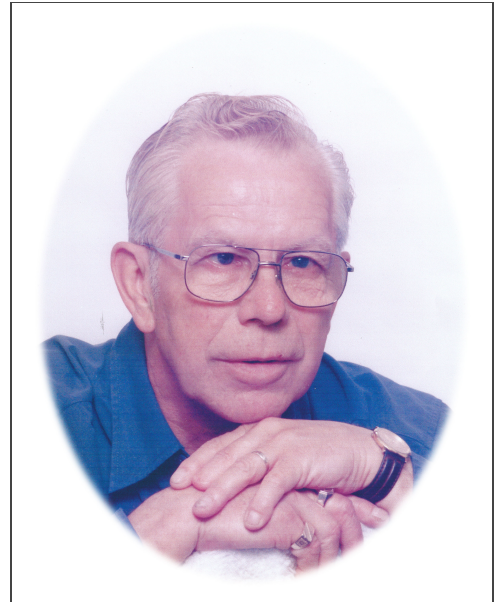
