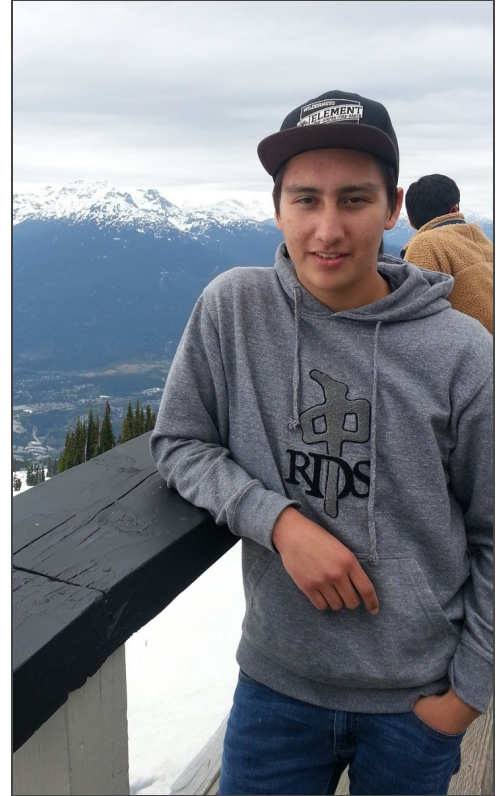


Philip Morgan Peters Jr.
