

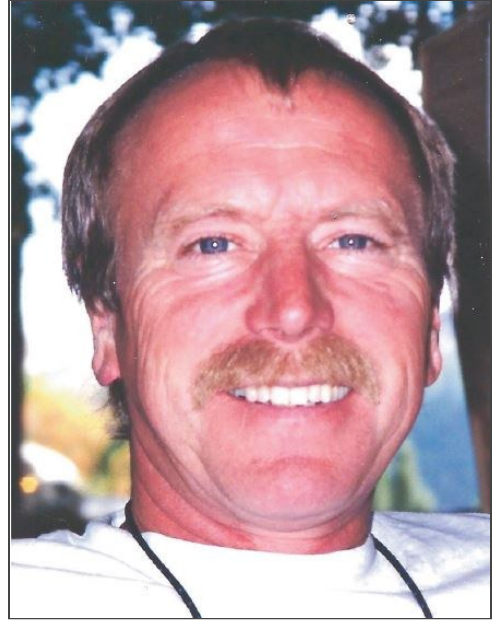
Alan John Poole
