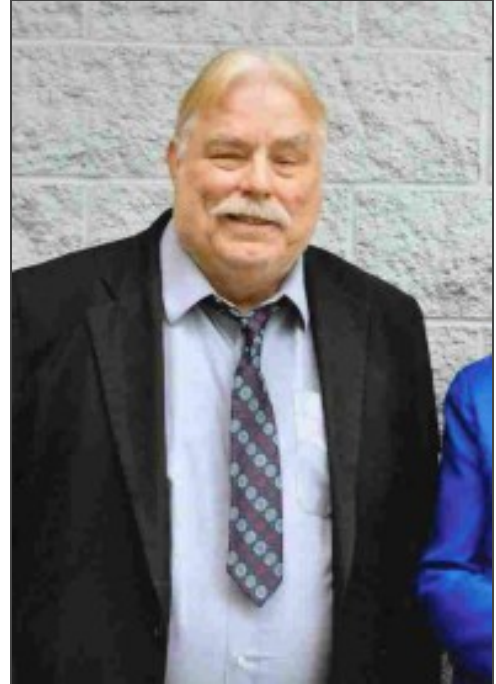


# Willem "Willy" Pors
