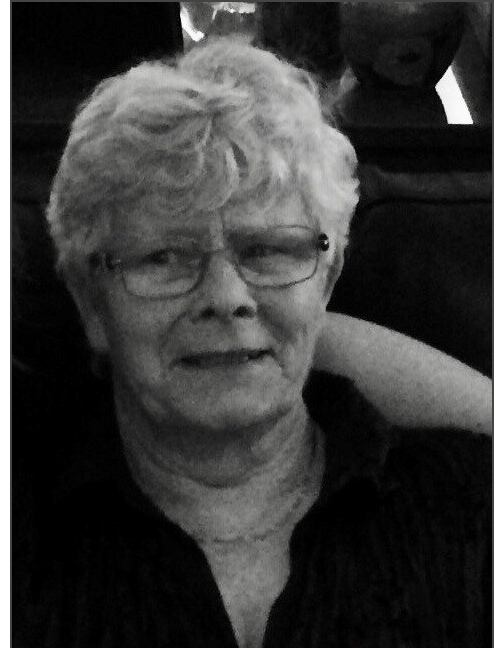
It is with profound sadness that the family of Maureen Mary Porter (Quinn) announce her sudden passing on Wednesday November 27, 2019 at the age of 74 years.
