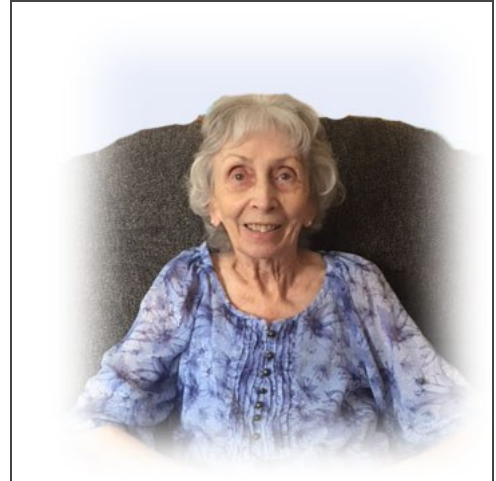


Elizabeth Ellen Preuss
