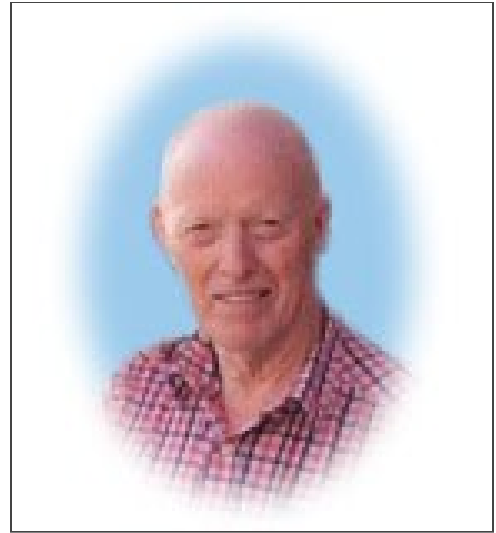


Louis Ronald Ray Pride
