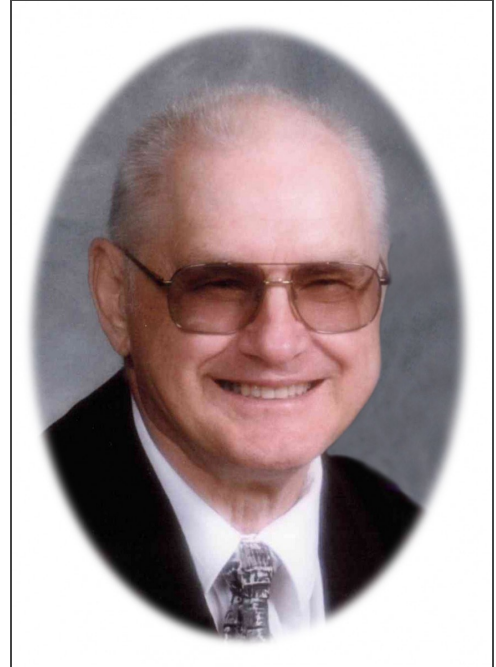


# Anton Protz
