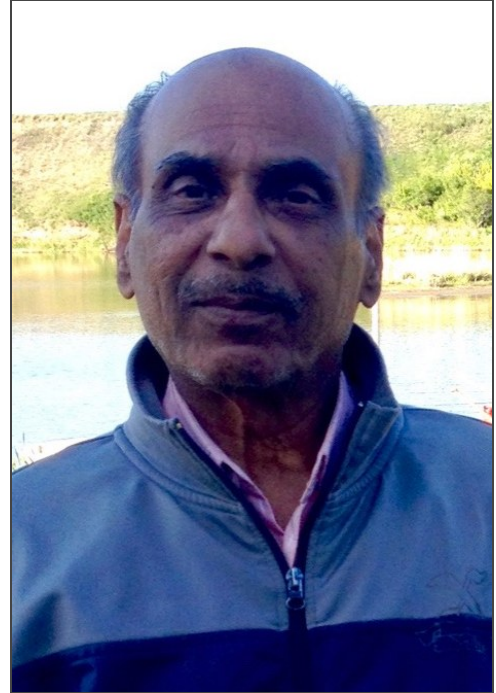


Philip Puthenveetil John
