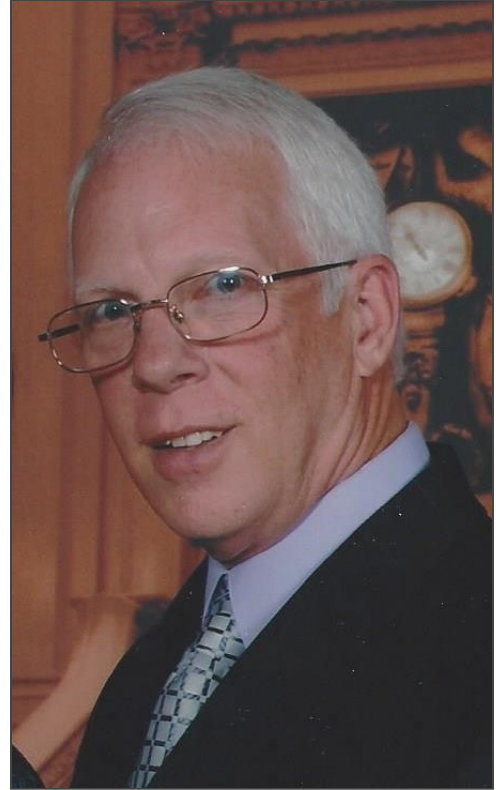


# Kenneth Fredrick Raison
