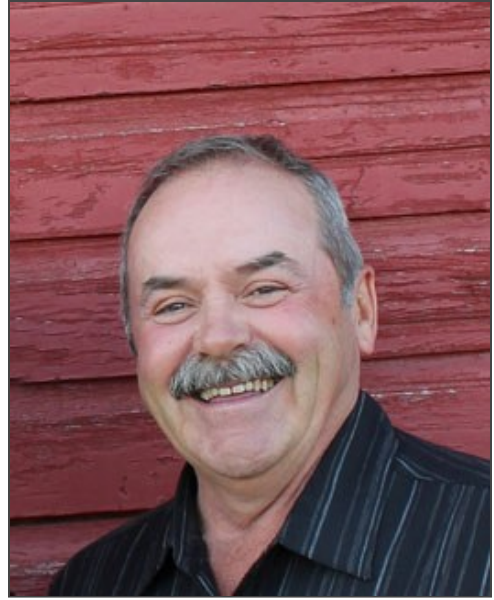


James "Brad" Bradley Ramsay
