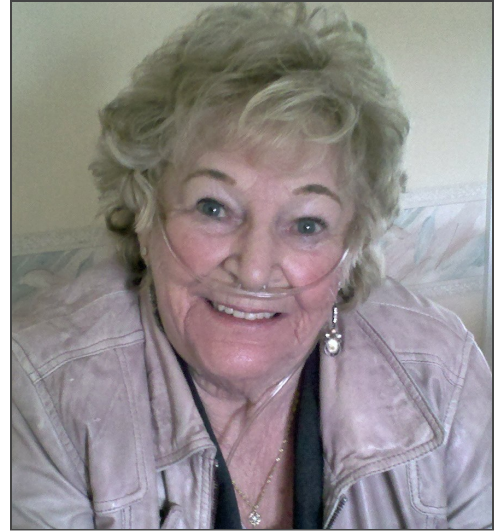


Carolyn Rathy
