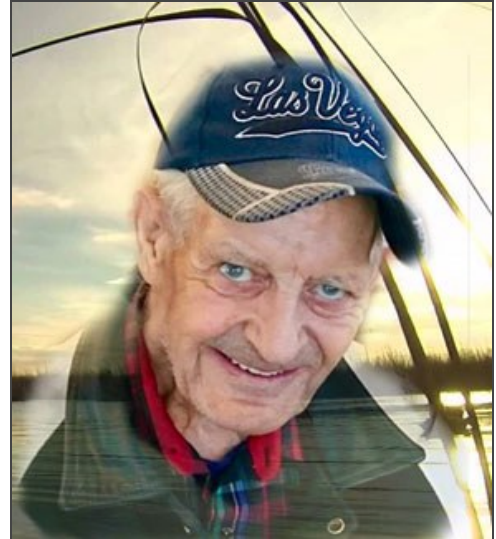


# Francis "Joe" Joseph Rehaume
