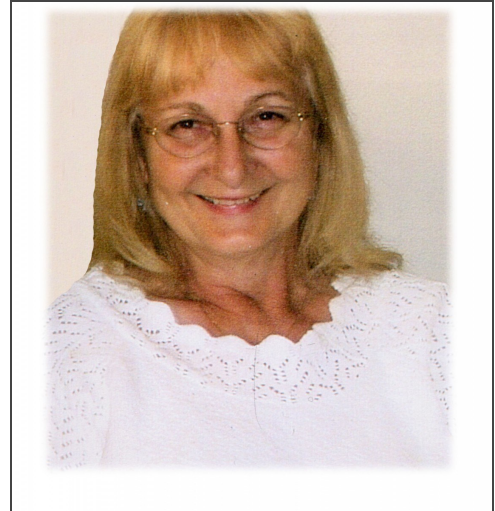


Pearl Kathleen Reid
