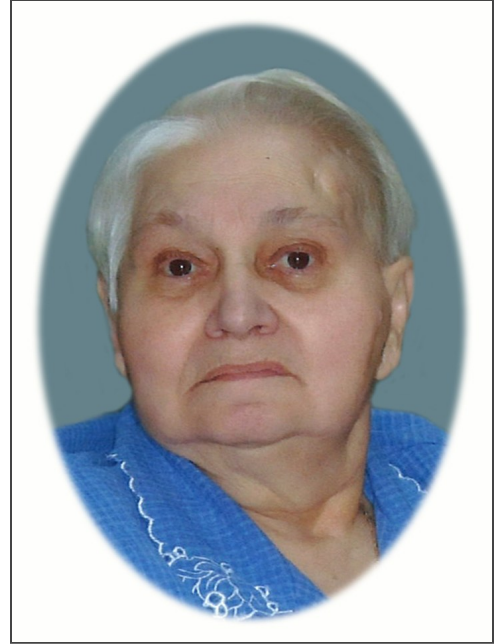


# Louise Ann Reiss
