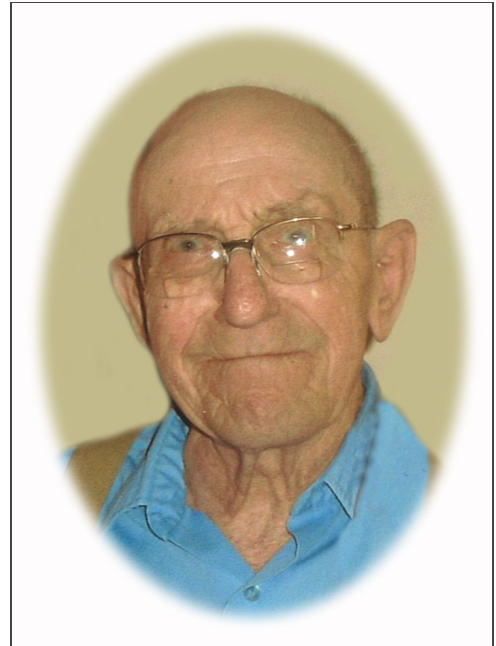


# Arthur "Art" Henry Resener
