

# Stacey Louise Richardson

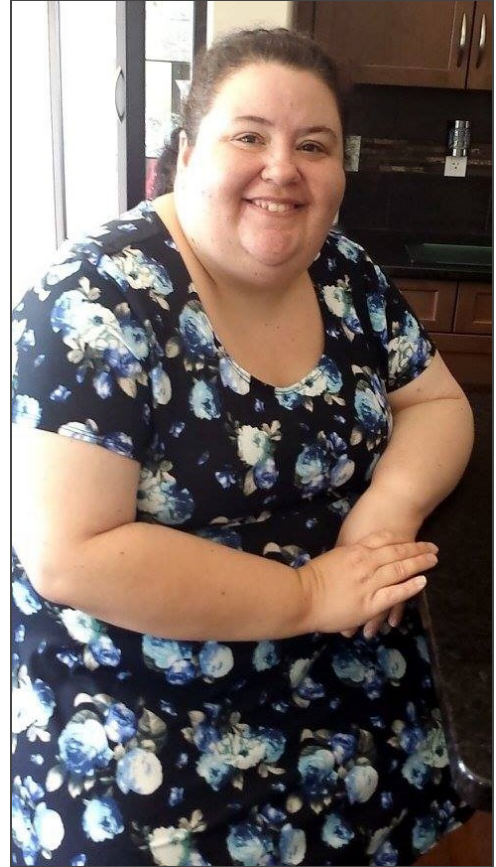
