Ruggero (Roger) Giovanni Rigoni, 77, passed away on Thursday April 19, 2012 at the Foothills Country Hospice in Okotoks, Alberta after a battle with lung cancer. Roger was born in Asiago Italy on June 24, 1934. He immigrated to Canada in 1956. After a brief stay in Kittimat, British Columbia he moved to Calgary and lived the rest of his life here. Roger worked for 55 years in the concrete business as a finisher and supervisor for Lafarge, Pro-Con Road works, Marmot and Professional Excavators. Roger retired at the age of 76.
