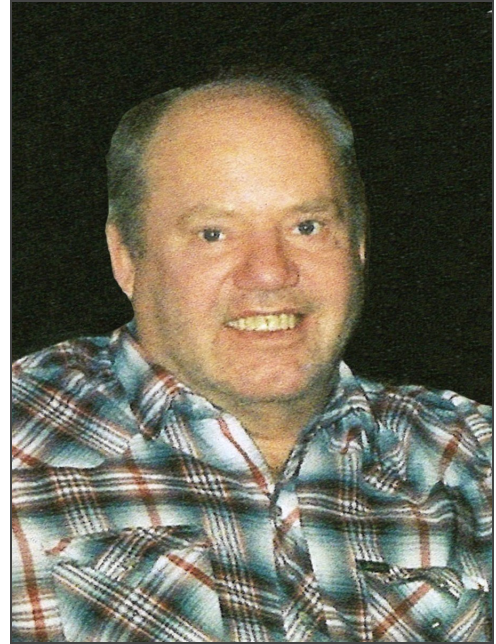


Ryan Vance Robertson
