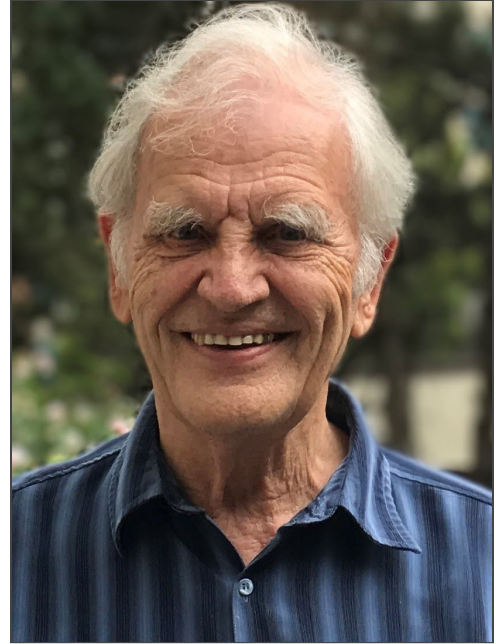


Jacob Romeyn
