will be lovingly remembered by daughter,

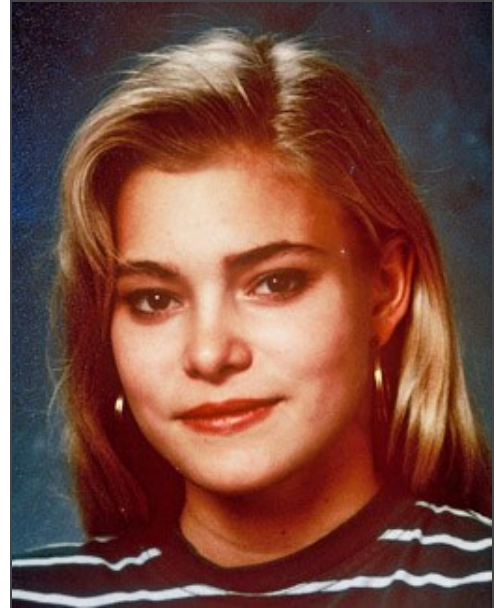
Tatyana Labrenz; adopted father, David Rose;
