Isobel Rowlands (Belle) passed away at Vancouver General Hospital on May 6, 2019, age 94. Predeceased by her husband, James (Jim); father, Robert Miller; mother, Edith (Hale); and sister, Ruth (Moore). Survived by her children, Robert, Anne (Greg), and Jane (Steve); her grandchildren, Meredith, Alexander (Olga), Ellen (Sylvain), Thomas, and Emma; great-grandson, Henry, and dear friend Becca.

Born in 1924, Belle lived most of her life in Montreal. After completing her B.A. at McGill University in 1946, she dedicated her life to her family and many friends. She loved gardening and quilting but more than anything, she enjoyed spending time with loved ones at her country home at Ste. Anne-des-Lacs, Que. In 2008, she moved to Vancouver to be closer to her family, but her heart remained in Quebec. Endlessly curious, Belle was a voracious reader who always had a book by her side and knew the answer to every gardening question. Belle was strong, opinionated, and fiercely independent; after a life-changing fall in September 2016 and an extended stay in Vancouver-area hospitals, she lived at Blenheim Lodge in Vancouver.
