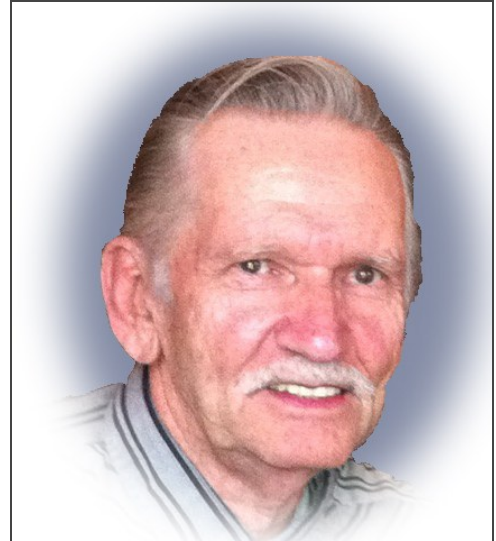


Neil Alexander Saunders
