

# Gary William Saxby

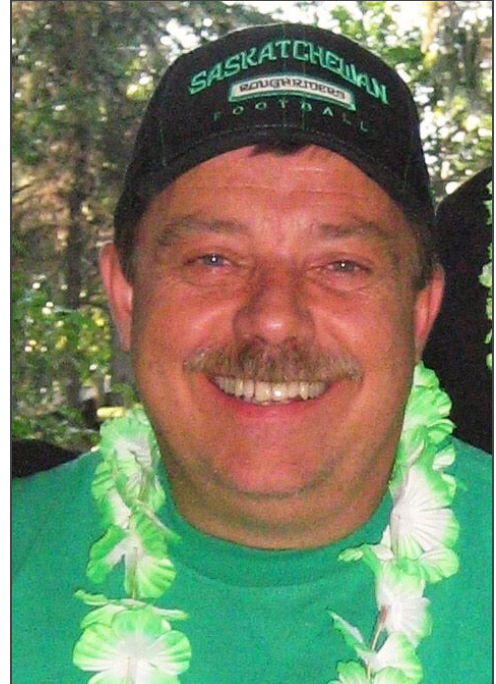
