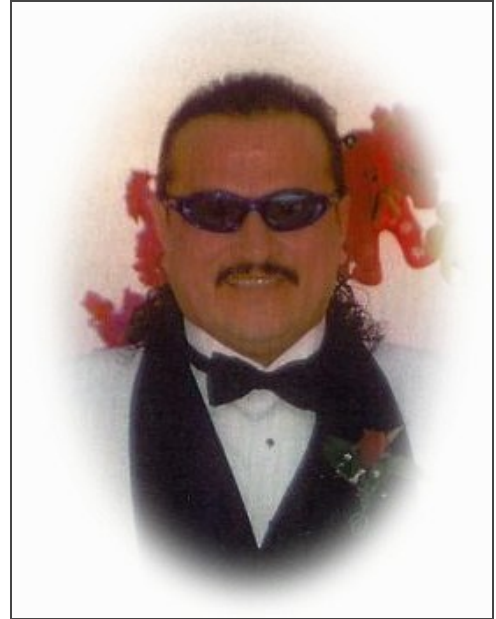


Dennis Leon Sayer
