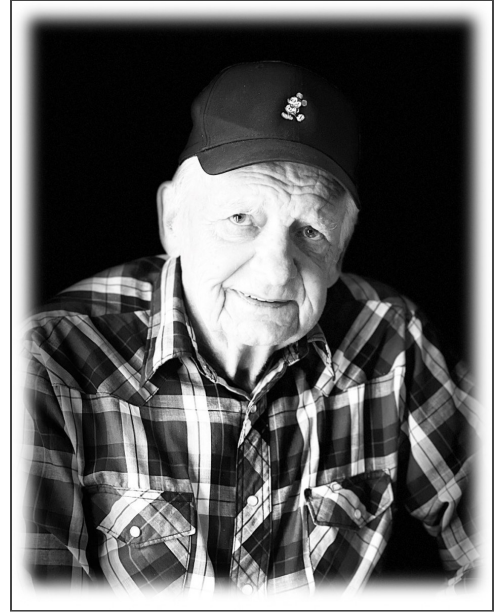


# Lawrence Edwin Sayer
