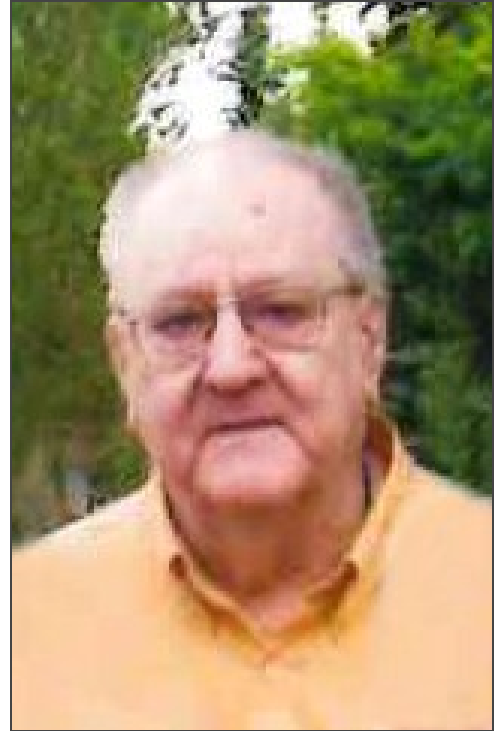


Norman August Schermann
