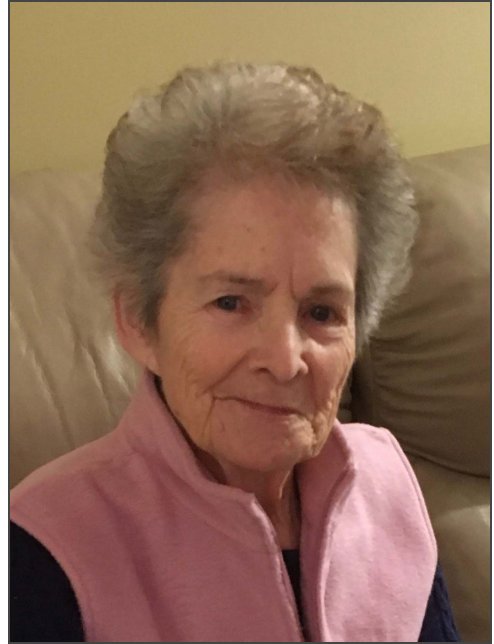


Anona (Nonie) Eileen Schmidt
