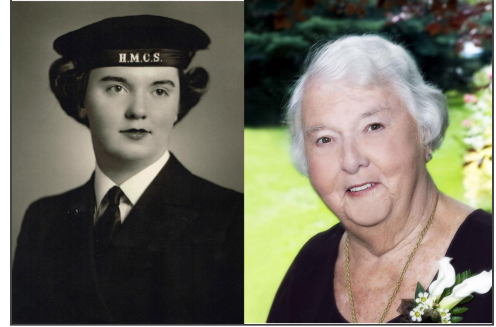


Maragret Roberta Scott
