

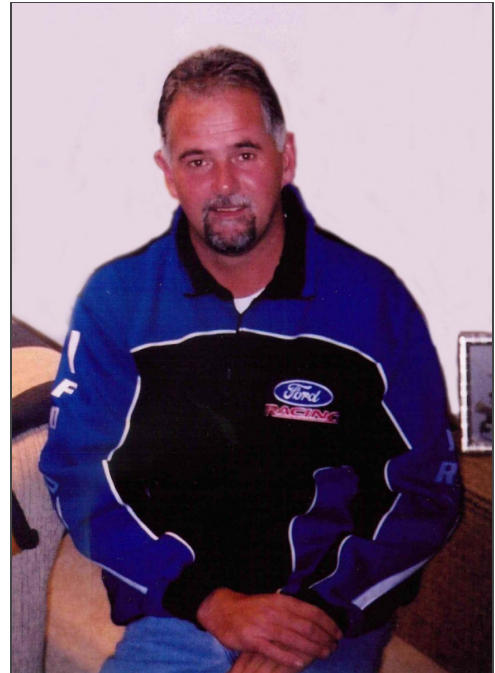
# Shane Lee Seib
