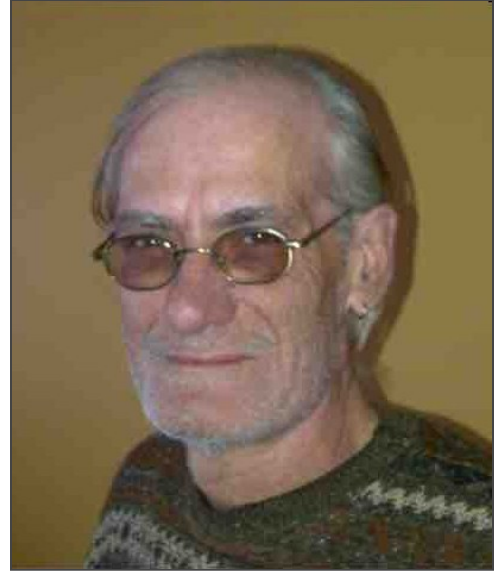


Andrew Seibel
