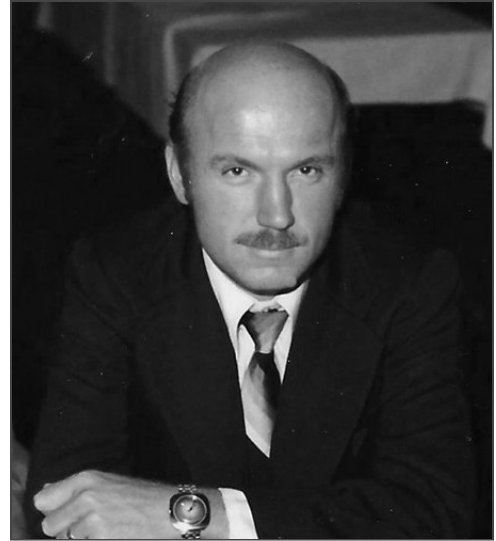


Peter Paul Sikorski

Peter Paul Sikorski passed away peacefully on Sunday, February 26, 2012. Born in Cologne, Germany. He attended a one room school in the Macalister lumber mill camp to grade 7, boarded in grade 8, and the family moved into Quesnel for high school. He attended NAIT in Edmonton and worked summers in the mills in B.C.



Predeceased by his father Paul Alfred Ulrich in 1956, and his mother Elizabeth (nee Carls) in 1995. Elizabeth married Joe Sikorski in 1958 and Joe was a wonderful father to Peter. Peter's favourite memory of his first year in Canada was learning to chop wood in the lumber camp. That love of wood must have led to his 40 year career in construction.
