

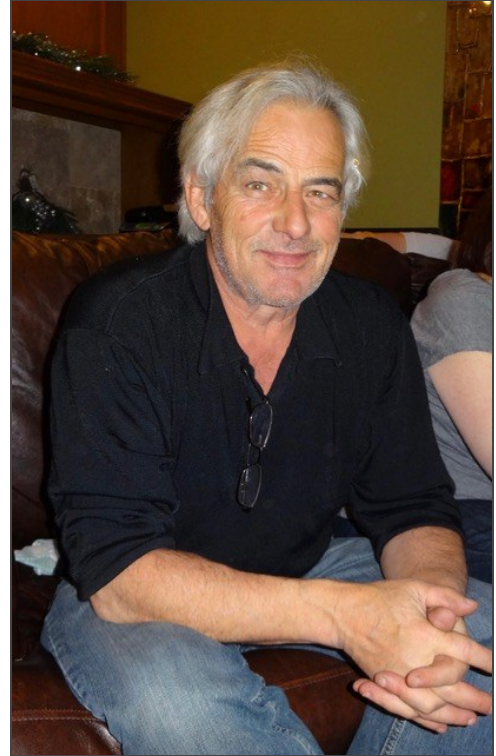
# Daryl Vernon Silzer
