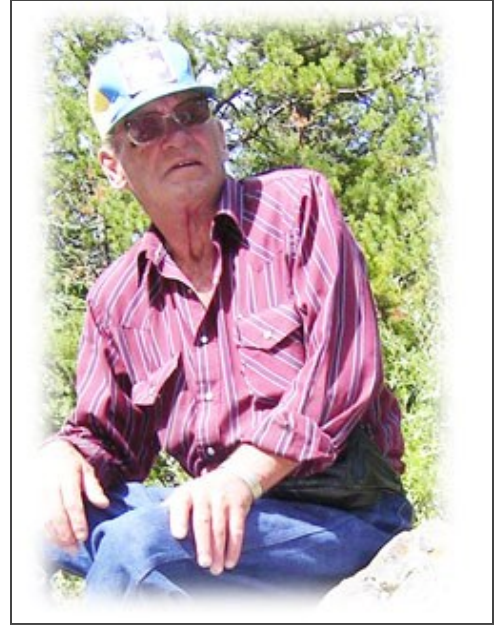


Allan "Smitty" Francis Smith
