

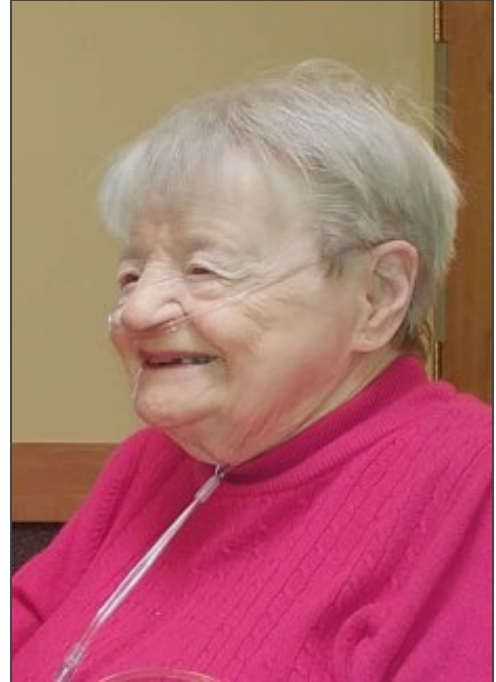
# Evelyn "Lena" Norma Smith
