sisters, Joy (Steve) Suitor, Judy (Lyall) Soroka and many nieces and nephews who

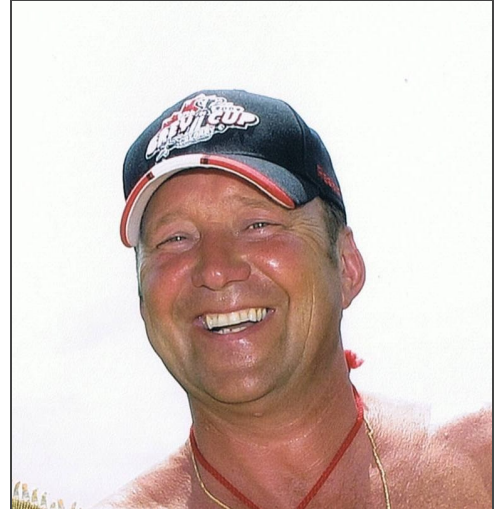
loved him deeply. Dale was predeceased by his father, Julian Soroka in 1983. A
