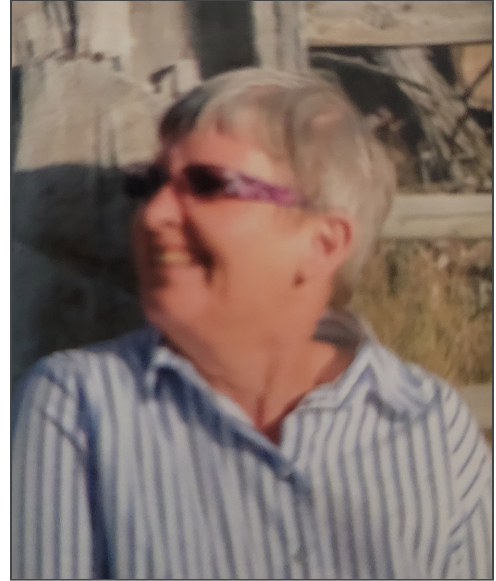


# Margaret Gordean Groggertt Stair
