

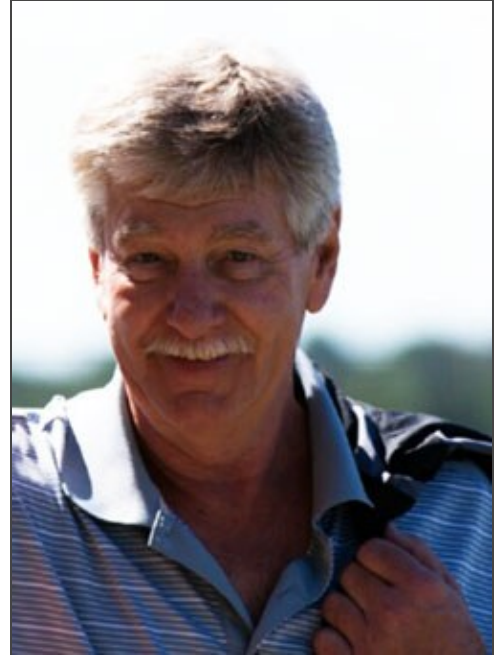
# Franklin "Frank" Ernest Stapley
