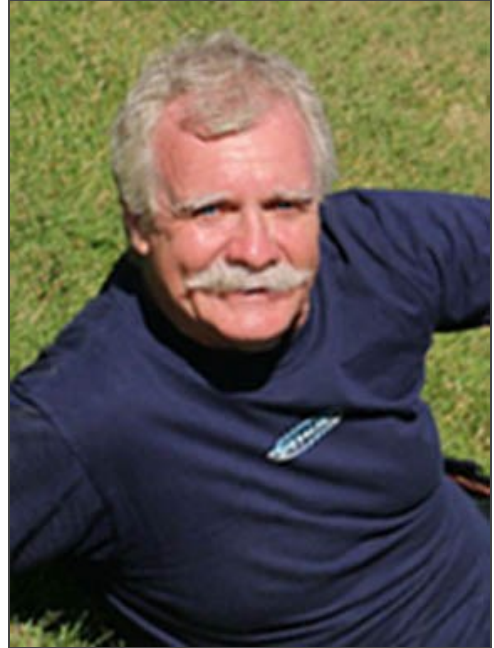


# James "Just Al" Allan Stickel
