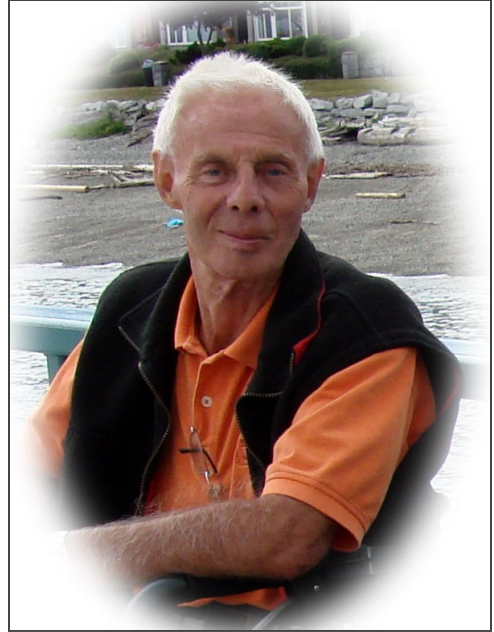


# William Harold Stokes
