

Gavril Sulyak

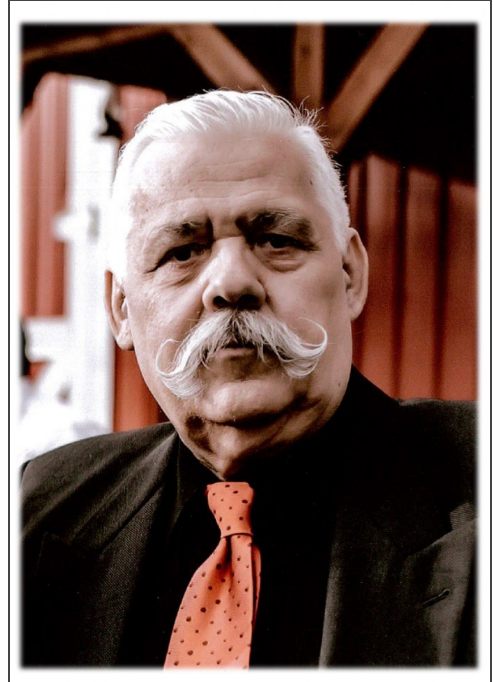
